

# Ohio Youth Soccer Association North

## Permission to Play Out of State/Player

The following guidelines will assist you when you need to receive permission to play out of your home state association:

1. Any youth player residing in Ohio North that wishes to play on a team of a member of a State Association other than Ohio North must receive written permission, using the Out of State Permission to Play/Player application, from Ohio North and also from the State Association of the team on which the player wishes to play.
  - a. Complete the enclosed Permission to Play Out of State/Player application and return to OYSAN. This State Office will obtain permission from the State Association of the team on which the player wishes to play.
2. The player, once permission is granted, must register with Ohio Youth Soccer Association North by completing the following:
  - a. Complete and sign U S Youth Soccer/OYSAN single year player membership form.
  - b. Picture attached to the back of the player pass and the player's signature is on the correct line. (1" x 1" color facial picture.)
  - c. Copy of birth certificate. Baptismal record or hospital certificate will not be accepted as proof of age.
  - d. Player I.D.# to be issued by the State Office.

Check payable to OYSAN in the amount of \$21.25 (inclusive of the \$8.00 Out of State Permission to Play fee.

This permission is granted for one seasonal year (September 1 through August 31) and must be reapplied for each year the player wishes to continue to play out of their home state association.
